

Memorial Butterfly Release

A butterfly release expresses by sight what the soul feels, and these unutterable emotions ride on the beating wings of an equally speechless butterfly. These soul sounds are carried throughout the air by the butterfly and all who observe their flight are connected by a special understanding of the event that has taken place.



Weather conditions will determine if appropriate as we do not recommend releasing butterflies at temperatures below 65 degrees F. as they become sluggish. Cemetery approval must be obtained.

Balloon releases are commonly used, and can be an environmentally safe way of memorializing and remembering our loved ones who have gone before us.



We use only latex balloons because they are totally bio-degradable . Subject to Cemetery approval.
